NOTIFICATION

No. RULE-503/37/2026-FOOD.— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 53 of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 (No. 1 of 2010), after consultation with the Government of India, the State Government, hereby, makes the following further amendment in the Chhattisgarh Legal Metrology (Enforcement) Rules, 2011, the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (4) of Section 53 of the said Act, namely: -

AMENDMENT

In the said rules,-

1. For rule 11, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“11. Registration of Manufacturers, Repairers and Dealers of Weights and Measures.-(1) Every manufacturer, repairer or dealer of weights or measures shall apply for registration online through the departmental portal, by furnishing a self-declaration, with the Controller of Legal Metrology or any other officer authorized by him for this purpose, for the issuance of a Certificate of Registration:

Provided that no certificate of registration to repair shall be required by a manufacturer to repair weight or measure manufactured by him and used in a State other than the State in which such weights or measures were manufactured, if the manufacturer gives prior intimation of such repair to the concerned Legal Metrology Officer.

(2) The Certificate of Registration shall be issued to a manufacturer, repairer or dealer in the appropriate form specified in Schedule II, on the basis of self-declaration without any prior inspection.

(3) The fee payable for the grant of a Certificate of Registration or for any amendment thereto shall be such as specified in Schedule IV.

(4) Manufacturers, Repairers and Dealers an application for any amendment in the Certificate of Registration shall be made online through the departmental portal on the basis of self-declaration.

(5) The Controller or any other officer authorized by him for this purpose shall maintain an online record/database of registered manufacturers, dealers and repairers.

(6) Every registered manufacturer, repairer or dealer shall maintain such workshop, equipment, tools, registers and other facilities, as may be applicable, in accordance with the Act, these rules and terms and conditions of registration.

(7) Every Certificate of Registration issued under the Act shall be displayed in the premises where the business is carried on.

(8) A Certificate of Registration issued under the Act shall neither be saleable nor transferable.

(9) The qualifications and experience required for applicants seeking registration as repairers of weights or measures shall be prescribed by the Controller from time to time.

(10) Every manufacturer, repairer or dealer shall comply with all the provisions of the Act and the Rules.

(11) The Certificate of Registration granted to a manufacturer, repairer or dealer under these Rules shall remain valid perpetually unless cancelled, in accordance with the provisions of the Act and these Rules and no renewal thereof shall be required.”

2. For rule 12, the following shall be substituted, namely: —

“12. Cancellation of Certificate of Registration.- (1) Where the Controller or any other officer authorized by him in this behalf has reasonable grounds to believe that -

- (a) any statement made in an application for grant of a Certificate of Registration or for amendment thereof is false or misleading, or
- (b) any provision of the Act, these Rules, or any order issued thereunder has been contravened, he may, upon completion of an inquiry against the holder of such certificate, cancel the Certificate of Registration:

Provided that, no Certificate of Registration shall be cancelled unless the holder thereof has been given a reasonable opportunity of being heard against the proposed action.

(2) Where the Controller or any other officer authorized by him in this behalf is satisfied that a registered manufacturer, repairer or dealer has contravened any provision of this Act, these rules or any order made thereunder, he may cancel such registration, after conducting such inspection as he may deem fit:

Provided that no Certificate of Registration shall be cancelled unless the holder thereof has been given a reasonable opportunity of being heard against the proposed action.

(3) Every registered manufacturer, repairer or dealer whose registration has been cancelled by the competent authority shall cease to carry on the activities authorized under such registration and shall not recommence such business. The weights or measures held in his ownership, possession or control on the date of cancellation of registration may be disposed of in such manner as may be prescribed by the Controller.

(4) No person whose registration as a manufacturer, repairer or dealer has been cancelled shall be eligible for re-registration more than once after such cancellation.”

3. In rule 13, for the word "licence", the word “registered” shall be substituted.

4. For sub-rule (6) of rule 15, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(6) A Legal Metrology Officer may visit, as frequently as possible during the period specified in rule, every premise within the local limits of his jurisdiction to inspect and test any weight or measure which is being or is intended or likely to be used in any transaction or for protection.”

5. After sub-rule (7) of rule 15, the following shall be added, namely: —

“(8) The competent authority for verification and stamping of different types of weighing and measuring instruments shall be determined by the Controller of Legal Metrology from time to time, in accordance with the prescribed provisions and based on the risk classification of such instruments. The Controller may, subject to such terms, conditions and qualifications as may be specified, authorize any Government agency, accredited institution, qualified person, or other third-party entity to carry out such verification and stamping.

(9) Where an applicant applies for re-verification within a reasonable period before the expiry of the validity of verification, the continued use of the weight or measure may be permitted until the completion of the re-verification process.”

6. In sub-rule (2) of rule 17, for the words “shall be” occurring after the words as additional fee, the words “may be” shall be substituted.

7. In sub-rule (3) of rule 17, for the words “shall bepayable”, the words “may be imposed” shall be substituted.

8. In rule 25, for the words "five thousand rupees", the words "one lacs rupees" shall be substituted.

9. After sub-rule (2) of rule 27, the following shall be added, namely: —

“(3) Improvement Notice and Compounding Notice.- The Controller or any other Legal Metrology Officer authorized by the Controller shall issue an Improvement Notice in the form specified in Schedule-XII, through electronic means in accordance with sub-section (6) of Section 15 of the Act:

Provided that, where any person fails to comply with an Improvement Notice issued in respect of a contravention of the provisions of the Act or these rules, a Compounding Notice for the offence shall be issued to such person by the Controller or any other Legal Metrology Officer authorized by the Controller, through electronic means, in the form specified in Schedule-XIII.”

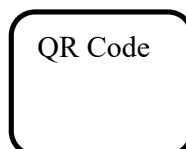

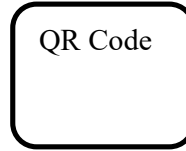

(h) Shall present the weight or measure instrument, after due repair, as the case may be, for verification and stamping in accordance with sub-rule (1) or sub-rule (8) of Rule 15 before returning to the user.

(i) If weights and measures instruments are repaired/fixed before the date of expiry of their validity of verification, and where in the process the stamp gets erased, separated or broken, shall present the same for re-verification and re-stamping under sub-rule (1) or sub-rule (8) of Rule 15 before returning to the user after due repair.”
